Be Geeks!

The musical band Be Geeks! got its name by no accident, as all the members are genuine math geeks. Among others, they love examining various properties of number sequences. Let's see an example of their subject of interest.

Let A be a nonempty sequence of positive integers, $A = (a_1, a_2, \dots, a_N)$.

Let $G(i, j) = \gcd(a_i, a_{i+1}, \dots, a_j)$, where $1 \leq i \leq j \leq N$.

Let $M(i, j) = \max(a_i, a_{i+1}, \dots, a_j)$, where $1 \leq i \leq j \leq N$.

Let $P(i, j) = G(i, j) \cdot M(i, j)$, where $1 \leq i \leq j \leq N$.

Let $F(A) = \sum P(i, j)$ over all pairs of integers $1 \leq i \leq j \leq N$.

The function `gcd` stands for the greatest common divisor of the given values. The greatest common divisor of a nonempty sequence of integers is the biggest integer which divides each integer in the sequence evenly.

Input Specification

The first line contains one integer N ($1 \leq N \leq 2 \cdot 10^5$). The next line contains N integers a_1, a_2, \dots, a_N ($1 \leq a_i \leq 10^9$).

Output Specification

Print the value of $F(A)$ modulo 1 000 000 007.
